

The BenRiach Distillery is located in the  
Betties and the town of Elgin, in the North-East of Scotland. The Spey Valley,  
the BenRiach Distillery was built by John Duff in 1898, is home to many of Scotland's  
great whiskies, but BenRiach has its own unique character, borne from the particular  
and skills of the men who craft the whisky, the  
stills and the high quality barrels.



Deep in the heart of the Speyside region, the BenRiach distillery, row upon row of oak casks,  
is an uninterrupted inventory of fine Speyside whiskies. The casks contain the highest quality  
whisky, which have taken the industry by storm. Some of the oldest whiskies are  
now available and testimony to the quality of the distillery.
